As of Sunday afternoon, The Victorian Government released its plan for easing coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions. It includes the following decisions about rural and regional school operations.

Schools will continue to provide remote and flexible learning for the remainder of Term 3, in rural and regional Victoria, consistent with current settings.

5 – 9 OCTOBER (FIRST WEEK OF TERM 4)

Remote and flexible learning will continue for students in rural and regional Victoria.

On-site supervision for children of permitted workers and vulnerable students will continue to be provided consistent with existing guidelines.

Outside school hours care will be available to students attending for onsite supervision.

FACE COVERINGS:

Wearing face coverings will be mandatory throughout
Victoria from 11.59pm on
Sunday 2 August. This means everyone over the age of 12 must wear a face covering when they leave their home for one of four reasons: study or work — if you cannot work from home, medical care and care giving, shopping for essentials & daily exercise.

Face coverings are also recommended in situations where maintaining 1.5 metres of physical distance is not possible

COMMUNITY GROUPS:

Community groups and the local community are not permitted to use the school facilities, including the playgrounds, school grounds, MPC and oval. Signs stating that the grounds are restricted will be placed at the gates and playgrounds.
